COACHES COMMENTS

Dave has been developed through the classic Academy route. Starting off in the 2007/08 season with Oxfordshire/ Wasps School of Rugby (SOR) as a 12 year old. During his years within the Oxon SOR, Dave was identified as a talented and aspiring young player and invited to attend EPDG sessions based at Henley RFC in season 2009/10. In September 2010, Dave made the decision to apply for a place in the Wasps AASE programme which was then based at Twyford High School.

After graduating from Twyford High School, Dave was duly promoted to the Academy EAP level - this is the highest Academy level, not available to the AASE players until they graduate. Having missed out on selection into Divisional level at U16, this was a particularly strong statement of intent. Having not been at a high performing Rugby school in Oxfordshire, Dave needed regular high level training to compliment his outstanding athletic ability. Very quickly Dave attracted interest from John Fletcher's England U18 Conference Squad and was duly promoted into this group, bypassing the traditional County, Divisional pathway. With a strong rugby programme to support him, Dave has made exceptional progress, benefitting from being around high performance players and receiving good direction from his coaches at Club and Rep level.

Dave has missed a good year of development due to injury and has
