This attractive patchwork quilt was expertly created in memory of Angela Cusden who, as we reported in the last newsletter, has sadly died.

It was designed by one of Angela's long-term friends, Jane Prowse, and will be auctioned at our February Open Day.

Angela, originally from Walsall in the Midlands, and Jane, from Deal in Kent, first met when they started training at the Nuffield Orthopaedic Centre in Oxford in December 1969.

When they were nearing the end

of their training, both applied to become state registered nurses at St Mary's Hospital at Paddington in London and both were accepted.

They kept in touch over the years and when Jane heard that Angela had died, she offered to make a quilt in her memory to raise funds for those with MS.

With the agreement of Angela's husband, Alan, we have decided to auction it and sell it to the highest bidder. If you are unable to come to our February Open Day and would like to bid for it, please let us know.
